The conference is organized by the Center for Geopolitics of Energy and Raw Materials, a research unit of the University Paris-Dauphine (France). In 2011, the theme of our annual conference devoted to a specific country will be "Energy in Poland". It is aimed at providing a better knowledge of the current situation and prospects in the Polish energy field to representatives of French companies, government offices, research centers and academics.
